Day 1. (Monday) USA – Johannesburg, South Africa
Depart Los Angeles for Johannesburg, South Africa.

Day 2. (Tuesday) Johannesburg (JNB)

Upon arrival at Johannesburg's Oliver Tambo International Airport, you will collect your luggage and then clear customs and immigration. You will be met by your representative who will assist and transfer you to your hotel.

3-Day Zimbabwe Victoria Falls Fly-In Tour

Experience the immense power of the Victoria Falls, a World Heritage listed site and a true natural wonder of the world. You will go on a guided safari to view the falls, take a cruise on the Zambezi River and have plenty of time to relax on this leisurely 3-day tour. The majestic Victoria Falls are a little over a mile wide, with a thundering vertical drop of up to 351 feet. During your stay you can sit back and relax on a sunset cruise on the Zambezi River, with the option of seeing the "African Spectacular" tribal dancing (optional).

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

You **MUST** confirm and obtain any visa requirements prior to arrival in Zimbabwe. All visa requirements are the sole responsibility of the traveler.

The Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe

Departure Point: Tour departs from Johannesburg Airport

Departure Time: 11:25AM. Please be at the airport 60-90 minutes before departure.

Return Details: Tour concludes at original point of departure at approximately 3:30PM on day 3.

Day 3. (Wednesday) Johannesburg Victoria Falls

Mid-morning departure. Hotel transfer upon arrival at Victoria Falls. Afternoon at leisure or you have the option of seeing the "African Spectacular" tribal dancing at an additional cost paid direct.

Overnight accommodation: A'Zambezi River Lodge

Day 4. (Thursday) Victoria Falls

After breakfast, a guided tour of the Victoria Falls, one of the seven natural wonders of the world. This walking safari take one through the magnificent rain forest to view the

Cataracts, Livingstone's statue and a wide variety of birds and plants. Then enjoy an afternoon sunset cruise on the Zambezi River.

Overnight accommodation: A'Zambezi River Lodge

Day 5. (Friday) Victoria Falls – Johannesburg

After breakfast, transfer to Victoria Falls Airport for return flight to Johannesburg International Airport.





In the morning, you will travel to Soweto (South Western Township), the largest former all-black township established by apartheid government policies. This tour includes the Chris Hani Baragwanath Hospital, Baragwanath taxi rank, Freedom Square, Hector Pietersen Memorial for the 13-year-old child who was the first victim of the 1976 street riots, and Nelson Mandela's former home. (B)
In the afternoon, you will transfer to airport and board your flight to Kigali, the capital of Rwanda.

Rwanda – The Land of a Thousand Hills

Its main attraction is the mountain gorillas found in Parc National Des Volcans. Rwanda is bordered by the countries of Uganda, Tanzania, Burundi, and the Democratic Republic of Congo.

Day 7. (Sunday) Parc National Des Volcans

After an early breakfast you will begin gorilla tracking through thick vegetation on the slopes of the Virunga Mountains then you will return to your lodge just in time for lunch.

Overnight Accommodation: Gorilla Nest Lodge/Kinigi guest house

A'Zambezi River Lodge

Set on the banks of the majestic Zambezi River and just a few kilometers upstream from the Victoria Falls, the lodge offers a true African experience. This informal lodge is a semicircular thatched structure located right next to the Zambezi National Park on the Zambezi River, just 4 kilometers from Victoria Falls.

Day 6. (Saturday) Kigali, Rwanda (KGL)





Day 8. (Monday) Kigali – Nairobi, Kenya (NBO) Masai Mara
After breakfast return to Kigali for your flight to Nairobi, the capital of Kenya. Upon arrival, proceed to Masai Mara through the Great African Rift Valley and Narok Town. You will then drive to Masai Mara Game Reserve which is famous for its black maned lion, zebra, elephant, buffalo, rhino, gazelle, leopards and giraffe. It is also

famous for its yearly migration of the wildebeest. You will arrive at your preferred lodge just in time for dinner.

Day 9. (Tuesday) Masai Mara Tour and Wildlife Safari
After breakfast, you will take a full day viewing and exploring this spectacular national park with a visit to the Mara River where the wildebeest migration takes place. In the afternoon, you will go for a game drive to explore Hemingways country, lions, cheetah, elephant, buffalo, zebra, giraffe, hippos, crocodiles and other animals. **Meals and overnight accommodation will be at the lodge/camp.**

Day 10. (Wednesday) Masai Mara Tour – Ngorongoro Crater, Tanzania

This morning you will drive from Arusha to Ngorongoro conservation area. You will reach your destination in the afternoon where you will check into your lodge and then go for a brief evening walk or relax at your lodge.

Overnight Accommodation: Ngorongoro Lodge, Tanzania

Day 11. (Thursday) Ngorongoro Crater

You will transfer to Ngorongoro Crater to spend the whole day at the crater floor viewing animals. You will have a picnic lunch and then drive to the top of the Great Rift Valley in the afternoon.

Overnight Accommodation: Ngorongoro Lodge, Tanzania

Day 12. (Friday) Serengeti

In the morning you will visit the Olduvai Gorge on your way to Serengeti. This is another world heritage site. You will reach the Serengeti in the afternoon and transfer to your lodge. You will have lunch and then go for an evening game drive. The Serengeti is known to be a home to many different types of animals.

Overnight Accommodation: Lobo Lodge

Day 13. (Saturday) Lake Manyara, Tanzania

After an early breakfast you will take a drive in the park and search for animals you didn't see the evening before. After the drive you will transfer to Lake Manyara to reach the park in the evening.

Overnight Accommodation: Lake Manyara Lodge

Day 14. (Sunday) Transfer to Nairobi, Kenya – USA

Go for an early morning game drive in the park before you drive back to Nairobi for your return flight back to the USA.





Trip cancellation insurance

Visa:

South Africa: United States passport holders do not require a visa for a visit less than 90 days.

Zimbabwe: United States passport holders require a visa which is only obtainable at the port of entry. \$60 USD for single entry and \$25 USD for airport departure tax. US dollars cash is required. We recommend the exact amount, as officials are not always in a position to give change. The Zimbabwe currency is the Zimbabwe Dollar. Official Rate: ZW \$250 = US \$1. *If you are offered exchange on the black market, **exercise extreme caution** as they are notorious for cheating you without even realizing it. There are reputable Bureau de Changes' in the main towns and at the airport. Most hotels, restaurants, travel agencies and the bigger shops will take credit cards and most of the bigger banks will advance the local currency against US Dollars cash or a credit card. Standard Chartered and Barclays Banks have ATM's which accept Visa cards for cash.

Rwanda: United States passport holders do not require a visa for a visit less than 90 days.

*International certificate of vaccination for Yellow Fever is required.

Kenya: Visa required. \$50 for multiple entries + handling fees.

*International certificate of vaccination for Yellow Fever is required if arriving from infected area within 5 days.

Tanzania: Visa required. \$100 for multiple entries + handling fees.

*International certificate of vaccination for Yellow Fever is required.

All Non- South African passport holders are required to have at least THREE, entirely blank (unstamped) visa pages (i.e. one side of each page not front and back thereof) in their passport, each time entry is sought into South Africa. These pages are in addition to the endorsement/amendment pages as the back of the passport. South African government regulations prohibit airlines from boarding passengers without the required blank visa pages.

Passports must be valid for a minimum of 6 months after the intended date of departure.
